



ATTENTION POSTER PRESENTERS!

General guidelines for posters for the IIC Turin Congress *Preventive Conservation: The State of the Art*

The posters will be displayed for the full week of the congress, and included in the poster sessions, where the presenting author is encouraged to be present to discuss the poster contents.

Poster format and guidelines

The poster design should be in portrait format at a maximum size of 84.1 cm x 118.9 cm. Reserve 10 cm at the top for the title (Arial 40 or an equivalent font and size), authors, affiliations, etc. Add a picture of the presenter of the poster for easy recognition of the presenting author. Add the title and logo of the IIC Turin congress at the bottom, in a similar manner. Use Arial 24 (or equivalent font and size) for text, in text blocks with a maximum width of 30 cm for the text.

The poster may be written fully in American English or fully in UK English, but not in a mixture of English and American spellings and style.

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IIC looks forward to receiving your contribution at the congress.
